Medications To Avoid

Anesthetic agents: Neuromuscular blockers

Antibiotics: Aminoglycosides, fluroquinolones, ketolides, macrolides

Cardiovascular drugs: Beta blockers, procainamide, quinidine

Corticosteroids: usually a standard treatment for MG but can cause worsening if MG symptoms are severe.

Other: Botulinum toxin, magnesium, hydroxychloroquine, quinine, statins, iodinated contrast agents.
